124-UNIT APARTMENT BUILDING ANNOUNCED FOR 4TH & L ST NW

A 124-unit multifamily apartment building with 6,000 square feet of retail is coming to the corner of 4th & L Streets, NW. The building is being developed by Blue Sky Housing, Paramount Development and Ellisdale Construction with design by architect BKV Group. The building will be 110 feet tall and offer mostly one-bedroom units. Ground breaking is projected to occur in August or September 2014 and delivery in the first quarter of 2016. 4th & L Street will join the strong MVT residential market with 3,689 residential units currently existing and under construction.

DCBIA PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS GROWTH OF MVT AS MIXED-USE NEIGHBORHOOD

On March 13th, the DC Building Industry Association hosted a morning panel discussion at the National Press Club about the Mount Vernon Triangle development dynamic. The presentations discussed the evolution of the MVT into one of the city's most vibrant mixed-use neighborhoods, the architectural design and concept of several



buildings and Boston Properties' and Steuart Investment's real estate decisions in planning and developing projects in the MVT.
